The criteria to select the student will be point based. It is only for college-bound Fall 2023 <u>high-school seniors</u>. It will be given only once per lifetime of the candidate. All the information provided in this email will be considered extremely private and will be shared only with the judges.

The points will be decided using the following:

- 1. High School GPA
- 2. SAT/ACT score: The highest score will be used.
- 3. Top five academic activities/awards achieved outside of classroom (in debate/math/science/arts/sports, etc.)

Winner of school award (e.g., 1st place in TMSCA, General Math in School)

- Winner of district award (e.g., 1st place in LD Debate at district level contest)
- Winner of State award
- Winner of National award
- 4. A personal essay by the applicant on an assigned topic (between 300 to 400 words)
- 5. Committee decision will be final and binding. All documents will be verified by the committee.

- Fill out all the information on the application form, including essay portion and convert the document into a PDF file. You may expand the space given as needed. Essay should be between 300 and 400 words.
- Attach a resume that includes all leadership roles, awards, and honors.
- Copy of SAT/ACT student score report, copy of school transcript through Fall semester of applicant's senior year and copy of AP Scores, if any
- Copy of latest school rank notification from school
- Copy of acceptance letter to the college
